

BYLAW NO. 2-86

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE OPEN BURNING OF GARBAGE
OR WASTE MATERIALS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF BORDEN.

The Council of the Village of Borden in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. That the burning of garbage, rubbish or waste materials within the Village of Borden shall only be allowed if the burning of such materials is done within a closed screen-covered container.
2. No open burning of waste materials shall be allowed unless written permission is first granted from the Village of Borden.
3. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provision of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village of Borden.
4. Bylaw No. 68-1 is hereby repealed.
