BYLAW NO. 4 OF 1996


A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS.

The COUNCIL of the VILLAGE OF BORDEN, in the PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw of the Village of Borden.
2. Section 3 applies only to an infraction of a bylaw of the Village for which no other fine is provided.
3. Subject to the provision of section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the Village, passed by authority of THE URBAN MUNICIPALITY ACT, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$2,000.00 and costs for every offence.
4. Subject to the provisions of section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a Bylaw of the VILLAGE OF BORDEN, passed by authority of THE URBAN MUNICIPALITY ACT, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 and costs for every offence.
5. BYLAW NO. 5/54 is hereby repealed.


